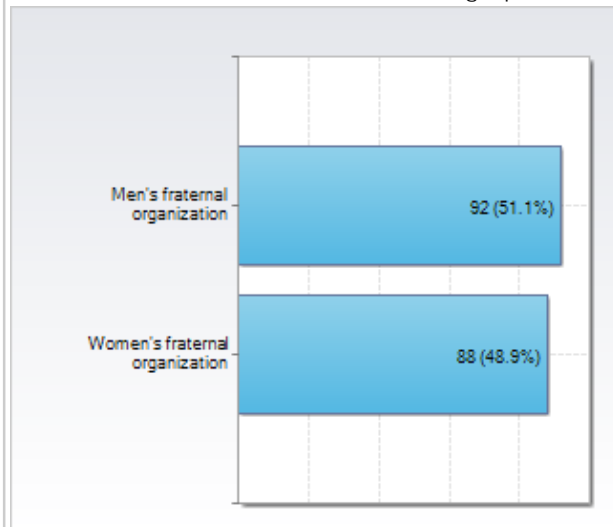

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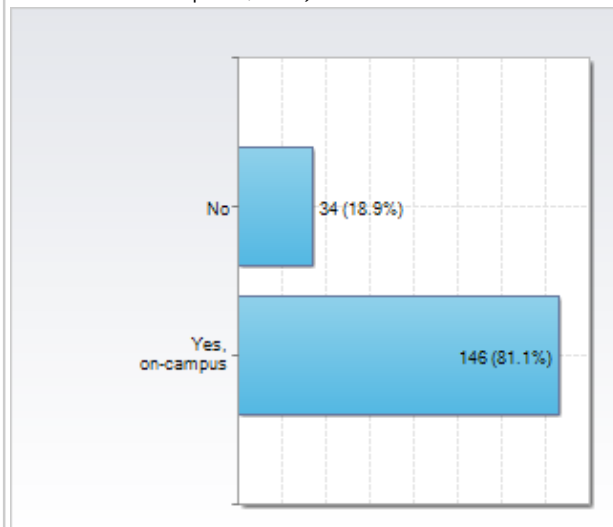

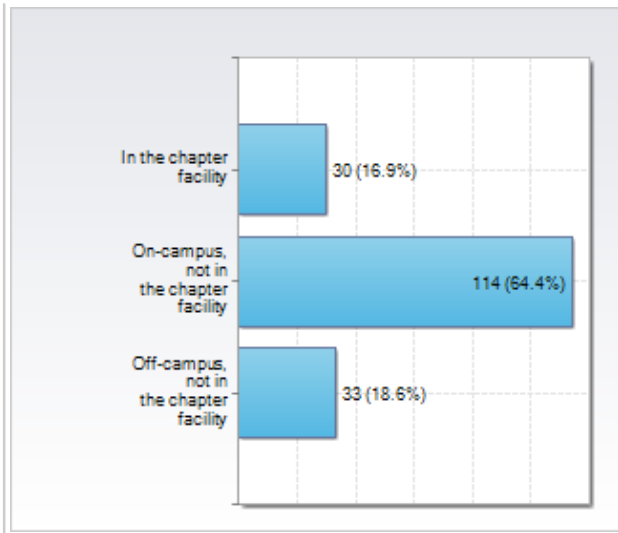

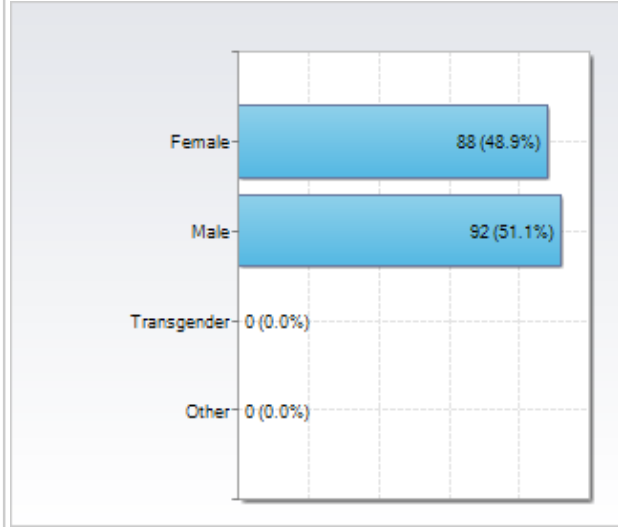

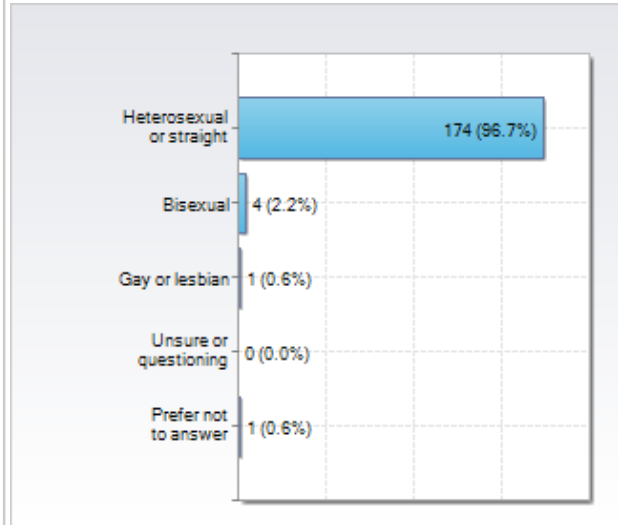

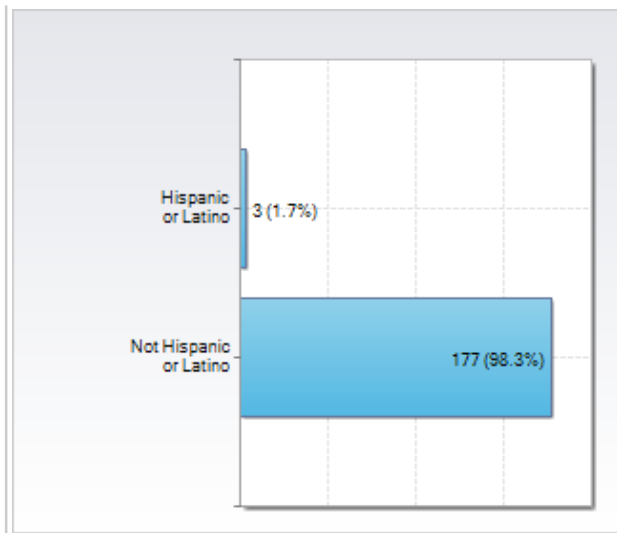

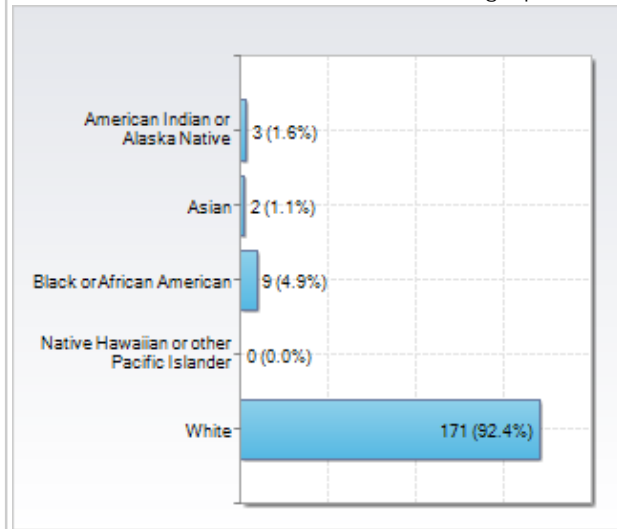

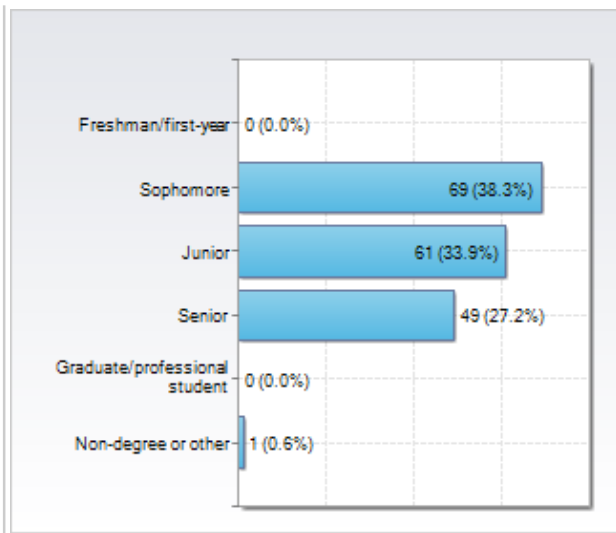

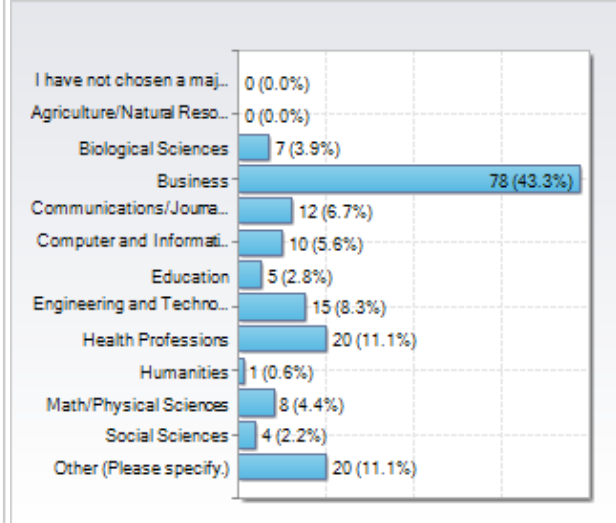

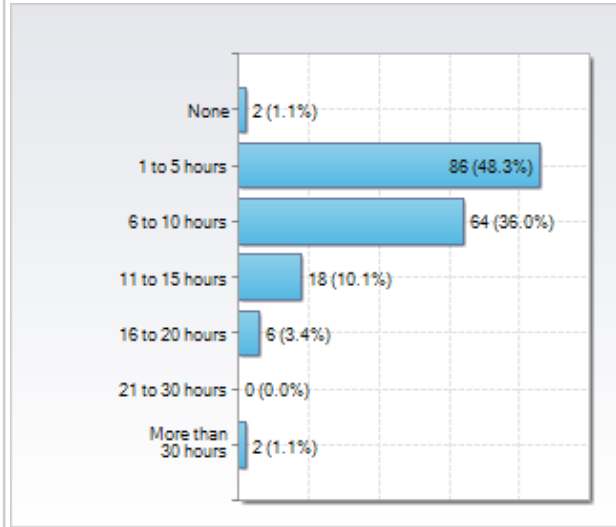

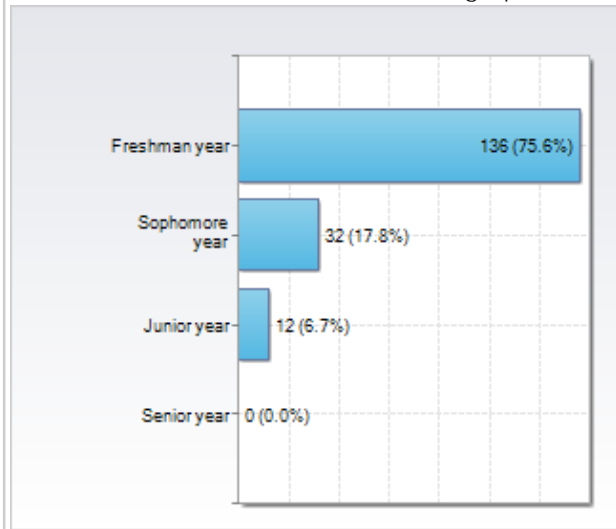

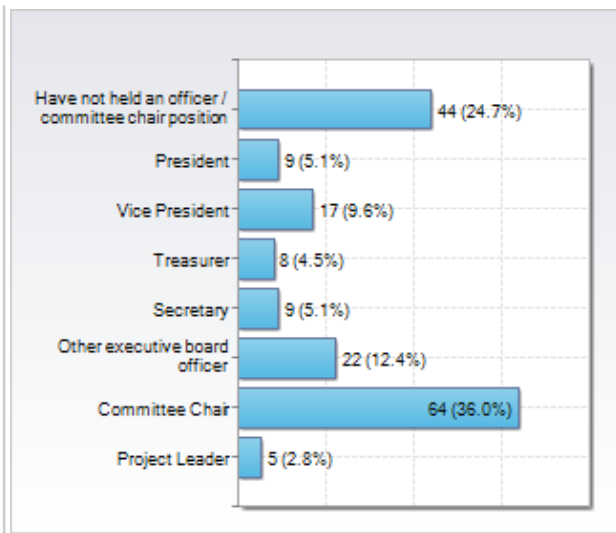

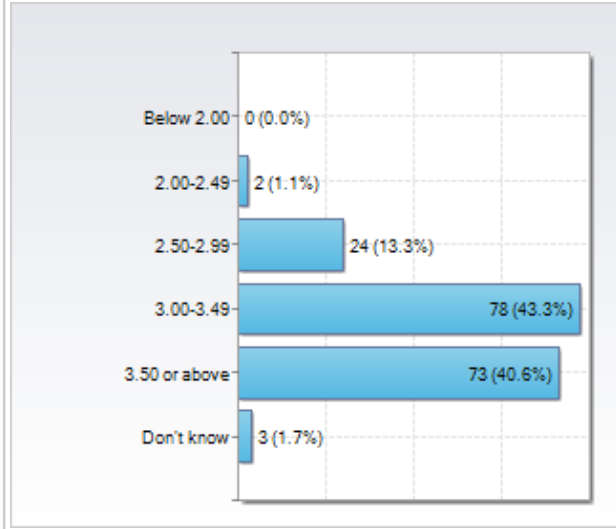

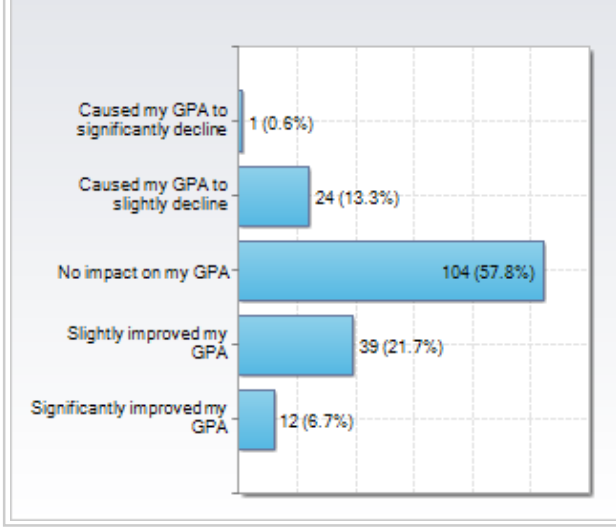

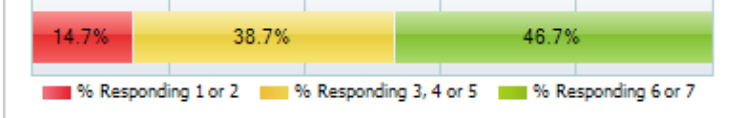

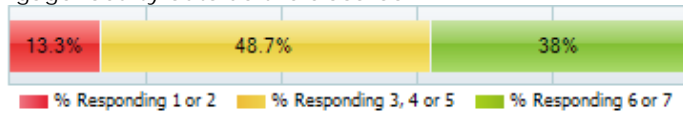
Q059. Practical Competencies - To what degree has your fraternity/sorority experience enhanced your ability to: Set priorities to accomplish what is most important
