APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Please follow the application guidelines related to the program of your choice.

1. All programs require the completion of the attached application and a non-refundable \$35 application fee, or apply online for free at rmu.edu.
2. International students are also required to complete the statement of financial support and must submit proof of health insurance, official TOEFL test scores and all official transcripts.
3. All programs require applicants to submit official transcripts of all undergraduate course work and graduate course work, if applicable. Official transcripts from all schools attended, whether or not some of the work is shown as advanced standing on your transcripts, must also be sent to the Office of Graduate Admissions.
4. All programs require two letters of recommendation to be submitted either directly from the recommender or in a sealed envelope enclosed with the application to the Office of Graduate Admissions.
5. Official test scores applicable to the program of choice should be requested from ETS (GMAT, GRE) or the Psychology Corporation (MAT) and sent directly to the Office of Graduate Admissions. Test scores are accepted by RMU only if taken within the last five years.
6. Certain programs require additional materials to be submitted. Refer to specific program insert sheet for any additional application requirements.
7. Students must submit ALL application materials required for the chosen degree before an admissions decision can be made. Send application materials to: Office of Graduate Admissions, Robert Morris University, 6001 University Boulevard, Moon Township, PA 15108-1189.

Robert Morris University accepts students on a rolling admission basis. As soon as all of your transcripts and other required credentials arrive in our office, we process your application and notify you of your admission status. To begin the admission process, complete this application and return it with your \$35 application fee.

GRADUATE TUITION PROGRAMS

THIRD PARTY BILLING

If an employer will pay for educational expenses regardless of grades received, a third party billing agreement may be entered into with the company or organization. To take advantage of this payment option, a voucher, letter of credit, purchase order or authorization to invoice will be required prior to the payment due date for each semester.

The billing authorization should include the following:

- A letter or voucher on your company's letterhead, including the original signature of an official authorized to obligate payment for your company or organization.
- Itemization of the fees and charges that the company will be responsible for paying.
- The semester during which the company will sponsor the student. The billing authorization will only be valid for one semester.
- The student's full name and RMU ID number.
- Name, billing address, telephone and fax number of the contact person at the company organization responsible for payment.

CORPORATE DEFERRED TUITION REIMBURSEMENT

The corporate deferred tuition reimbursement plan permits students to defer payment of the reimbursed portion of their tuition until approximately 30 days after the semester.

Participants must:

- Submit an application, including a non-refundable \$25 processing fee
- Provide proof of tuition reimbursement by their company
- Re-enroll in the program each semester

TYPES OF PAYMENT

Robert Morris University offers a variety of tuition payment options for your convenience including a deferred payment program and an interest free monthly payment plan. American Express, Visa, Master Card, and Discover credit cards are also accepted. TO APPLY FOR FINANCIAL AID, FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) as soon as possible after January 1. To file the FAFSA electronically, visit fafsa.ed.gov. RMU's FAFSA code is #003359. Be aware of filing deadlines in your homestate (Pennsylvania's filing deadline is May 1.)**
- 2. A Student Aid Report (SAR) will be sent to you via e-mail 7 to 10 days after you have submitted your FAFSA (you should keep the SAR for your records). If you are required to make corrections, do so online. A portion of FAFSAs will be selected for verification. If yours is chosen, you will need to complete and return a verification worksheet along with copies of your 1040(s) to the Robert Morris University Financial Aid Office.**
