IMPORTANT NOTES:

COSO0990, MATH0900--These courses may be required but do not fulfill requirements for graduation in this degree program.

All students must take 12 credits of Communication Skills as part of the RMU Core Curriculum. Depending upon placement testing scores, students will take COSO1220 or COSO2221 in addition to COSO1221, COSO2220, and COSO2230. If placed in COSO1220, a student's Core requirements are Communication Skills COSO1220, COSO1221, COSO2220, and COSO2230. If placed in COSK1221 (advanced placement; no credit earned for COSK1220), a student's Core requirements are Communication Skills COSO1221, COSO2220, COSO2221, and COSO2230. Upon completion of the COSK courses, students must complete a component of courses (the specific number is determined by the student's "academic" School) to meet one of the requirements for graduation. These courses called "Communication Skills Intensive" are integrated into the degree as part of the "major" areas of the checksheet.
