
D003. Personal Characteristics - Demographics: What is your residence?






D006. Personal Characteristics - Demographics: What is your ethnicity?






D009. Personal Characteristics - Demographics: What is your current academic standing?






D014. Personal Characteristics - Demographics: In an average month, how many hours do you spend on community service activities?





