



Measure 2: Employer Satisfaction

To measure the satisfaction of employers with the preparedness of RMU graduates, employers of RMU alumni are surveyed. Employer survey is fielded to all known employers of education alumni three years out of completion. The results are presented in Table 1. Results of 2020-2021 and 2021-22 indicate employers were satisfied with the level of preparedness of RMU graduates. Results are not reported for programs when the sample size is small, therefore disaggregated results are not presented for external constituents.
