



# Measure 2: Stakeholder Involvement

Each year the Education Department faculty, staff and/or administrators reach out to multiple stakeholders to provide updates on the education programs at RMU and seek input from stakeholders themselves. Below is a summary of relevant stakeholder events and topics for the 2022-2023 academic year.

- Education Conference: October 10, 2022
   Each year RMU hosts an education conference for local teachers and administrations. The 2022 RMU Trees
   Network Special Education Conference was held virtually. The conference entitled Moving Forward
   Together provided over attending pre-service education students, teachers and administrators with
   opportunities to learn about a variety of topics including behavior management, math strategies, IEPs and
   ELLs, PASA and DLM, Co-Teaching, and Structured Literacy. The keynote speakers were Laurie Vander Ploeg,
   Associate Executive Vice President, CEC; and Dr. Allison Dubois, Mindful Mind Solutions.
- Virutal Mentoring: Monthly thorughout the school year In 2022-23, RMU education faculty members held virtual mentoring sessions throuhgout the school year to enlighten and educate high school students about different opportunities available in the education field as part of Education Professionals Mentoring High School Program with RMU, 2022-23. The monthly program was conducted virtually. The sessions were recorded and shared with all the schools following the program. Students were able to submit questions in the chat box. The sessions were held on the first Thursday of the month, First Thursday of each month, beginning in October 2022. The session topics were: October 6: Overview of the Education field & Hot Topics: SEL; November 3: Early Childhood (PreK-4), Early Intervention (Dr. Tepe & Dr. Maria Paul); December 1: Middle, Secondary levels & Curriculum (Dr. Kardamibikis w/Mclain and Hannah Szecanzy current RMU students); \*January 12: Special Education, Reading Specialist, English Language Learners, (Dr. Bill Scheichler, Dr. Bernadowski, Dr. Ying Zhang w/ Nic Lindelow and Hannah Fowler current RMU students); February 2: Educational Administration (Drs. Scott Miller, AW, Katherine Roche, WA); March 2: Teaching abroad (Dr. Taylor, Sam King); April 6: On Campus/Pathways to Education Professionals Role (Participating students and teachers were invited on campus for a panel discussion with current educators and students to discuss pathways to become an Education Professional). \*2nd Thursday due to RMU semester break.
- 3. Advisory Meeting with Cooperating Teachers and University Supervisors
  In 2022-23, RMU held an advisory meetings and end of year feedback meetings each semester. These meetings continue to inform our teacher education program. These meetings were held on campus at the end of student teaching.
- 4. Student Teaching Seminar Experiences Each year, RMU's teacher candidates engage with practitioners from the field duing the reuirqes student teaching seminar experience. RMU's teacher education program has strong partnerships with its stakeholders that allow for such opportunities, some of which take place as part of coursework. During student teaching siminar, the teacher candidates participate in mock intervies and resume building experiences with activing principals from the community. RMU is commtitted to preparing educators in collaboration with its community and stakeholders.

#### Consortia Involvement

Two faculty members joined a Higher Education Consortium (HEC) that meets quarterly with other early childhood higher education faculty to discuss issues, problem solve and brainstorm ideas to strengthen the field of early childhood education. The HEC members teach at institutions of higher education across the state of Pennsylvania and met virtually throughout the year, and in person in Harrisburg, PA in June, 2022. Information is shared as appropriate at RMU faculty meetings with the faculty at large.

#### 6. Statewide Involvement

Faculty and staff are also part of a state-wide field coordinators group. They meet virtually once a semester, and regularly touch base via electronic communication and newsletters. This group provides insight into PDE requirements, changes, and other pertinent information regarding student field hours (including pre and student teaching hours).

### 7. Memorandums of Understanding, 2022-2023

During the 2022-2023 academic year the Department of Education at RMU continued MOUs with scores of local schools/districts. The purpose of the MOUs is three-fold: 1) It creates an opportunity for our pre-service teachers to conduct their pre-student and student teaching experiences in a variety of schools including rural, suburban, and urban settings. This allows our pre-service teachers to experience a host of different educational environments before graduation. 2) The MOUs allow for research to take place in schools where we have an existing relationship with the school. The research strengthens educational faculty in preparing future teachers for their work after graduation. 3) TheMOUs provide an opportunity to provide professional development opportunities for RMU and school districts in the region.
