



## Ability of Completers to Meet Licensing Requirements

The Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE) requires passing of Content Exams based upon the certification content area. These are a series of Pennsylvania Educator Certification Tests (PECT) from Pearson Education or Praxis II exam(s) through Educational Testing Service (ETS). RMU teacher candidates take the licensure exams prior to student teaching.

## **Initial Certification:**




Figure 1. RMU Initial Licensure Certification Test Pass Rates vs. Statewide Pass Rates

Student scores are received by RMU and PDE from ETS/Pearson via the Title II Program Completer PassRate Report. ETS pass rates do not include those students who passed based on PDE GPA Qualifying Score, PDE Composite Scores, or PDE Approved Coursework Equivalencies. RMU pass rates are typically above the state pass rate (see Figure 1). Summary institution-level pass rate data are presented in Tables 1 and 2 and indicate that RMU program completers typically have a higher pass rate than the statewide pass rate. Results are not reported for programs when the sample size is small, therefore disaggregated results are not presented for external constituents but are available for CAEP reporting purposes. The data strongly support the claim that students enrolled in initial certification programs at RMU are able to demonstrate proficient knowledge of subject matter in their area of certification.

The Title II Program Completer Pass Rate Report from ETS provides data on the RMU average scaled score and PA statewide average scaled score. ETS notes that pass rates are not reported when there are less than 10 students taking an exam. As RMU is a small program, this means that pass rates for several of the programs are not represented in this report. However, data from our two largest programs, the Early Childhood and the Early Childhood/Special Education program, are represented and are presented in Table 2. These data indicate cut score pass rates are at a high level.

## **Advanced Certifications:**

Advanced certification test score results are not received via the Title II Program Completer Pass Rate Report. Individual student state teacher licensure test results are pulled from ETS and Pearson and recorded by the Certification Specialist. Results for all advanced programs are presented in Table 3 and results are disaggregated by program in Tables 4-6. These results are presented by students' program completion year. The data strongly support the claim that students enrolled in initial certification programs at RMU are able to demonstrate proficient knowledge of subject matter in their area of certification.




Figure 2. RMU advanced Program Licensure Certification Test Pass Rates

Individual candidate state licensure test results are pulled from ETS and Pearson and recorded by the Certification Specialist. Results by program are presented in Tables 2 to 4. These results are presented by students' program completion year. Note that there is not a state testing requirement for students seeking the Instructional Technology Specialist certification, Online Instruction endorsement, Autism Spectrum Disorders endorsement, or ESL.
